#### WELCOME AND INTRODUCTIONS

Darge took roll call. Chair Ryan called the meeting to order once a quorum was established.

#### **APPROVAL OF MINUTES**

Chair Ryan requested approval of the July 1, 2024 meeting minutes. Motion was made by Hennessey and seconded by Stiles; motion passed unanimously.

#### **DIRECTOR'S REPORT**

Jonathan McRoy was recognized for his contributions to the board.

- Projects
  - Clemons Aviation has begun construction on a new hangar north of the current location.
  - Bids will be accepted on 8-9-24 for the new taxiway A-1 South at Jabara. The

project is expected to begin September or October.

- Airport Hotel will not be making the December 1 deadline. A new date will be presented to the council for an extension to the agreement.
- Due to the city's water shortage adjustments will be made to watering schedule. Signage has been placed referencing well water usage.
- Jabara is on city water and will adjust watering schedules according to water restrictions.
- Wi-fi in the terminal is down and a quick resolution is being worked on.
- Captain Potter with the Airport Police and Fire will be providing part of the service for the fallen firefighter Ty Voth's funeral on Friday.
- Staffing
  - Romo gave an update on current job postings.
  - Air Service
  - Due to the Crowdstrike outage on July 18, 17 flights were cancelled, and 17 flights were delayed.
  - New passenger record was set in June with 175,800 passengers, the previous record was 169,541 in June 2019.
  - First 6 months of this year passenger traffic exceeded the 2019 record year by 2%.
  - June enplanements increased 11% while seats increased 8%.
  - American increased capacity to Dallas by 8.6% and to Chicago by 87.4%
  - United added a 4th flight to Houston which is a 35% increase.
  - The airport will not be applying for the Small Community Air Service Development (SCASD) grant as the airport was unable to secure support from the airlines.
  - Department of Transportation is offering a Kansas Air Service Development Initiative grant for incentives to attract new services. An application is being processed to apply for \$1 mil as a minimum guarantee for service to Charlotte.
